1. **NOTICE OF MOTION IN THE NAME OF COUNCILLOR H. MC GRATH**

“That Nenagh Town Council look at other options in relation to carrying out repair work on lights on our main streets. There are at least 4 lights on our main streets that are not working, i.e. one outside Supermaes, Mitchel street is left in the dark at night for the last month. They are local contractors that could carry out this work if they were asked. These contractors look after our pedestrian crossings and have a good record in keeping them repaired. I believe they should be allowed to tender for maintenance of our lights in the town. With so many lights breaking down on the street, I wonder did we pick a good quality light.”
