

***GUIDELINES FOR ERECTION OF SCAFFOLDING – LICENCE UNDER SECTION 254 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2000***

---

1. The scaffolding shall be erected in accordance with the Construction Regulations 2001/2006
  - (a) Scaffolding should only be erected by a competent person who has completed the FAS CSCS Course.
  - (b) A GA3 Form (see Construction Regulations 2006) must be completed and handed over to the Council by the competent person on completion
  - (c) A means of identifying when the scaffolding is safe or unsafe to use such as Scafftag must be used.
  - (d) Regular inspections of the erected scaffolding should be undertaken by a competent person in particular after bad weather (e.g. high winds)
2. The scaffolding shall be fitted with an appropriate mesh netting or hoarding and shall be adequately signposted and lit at night for the protection of pedestrians.
3. The contractor shall maintain a walkway for pedestrians, suitably protected, outside the scaffolding.
4. North Tipperary County Council and Nenagh Town Council shall be indemnified against Public Liability during the course of the work. Proof of adequate insurance must be submitted before scaffolding is erected.
5. Licence fee in the amount of €125 to be submitted.

***GUIDELINES FOR PLACEMENT OF SKIPS – LICENCE UNDER SECTION 254 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2000***

---

Placement of a Skip on a public thoroughfare requires a licence under Section 254 of The Planning and Development Act, 2000.

Details of skip, to include exact location, size, duration of time that skip will be in situ and details of precautions taken to ensure health and safety guidelines have been complied with to be submitted.

Licence fee in the amount of €125 to be submitted. In the event of loss of car parking spaces, a fee for such space in the amount of €7.50 per day is also required.
