

NOTICES OF MOTION

1. NOTICE OF MOTION IN THE NAME OF COUNCILLOR HUGHIE MC GRATH

"That Nenagh Town Council increase public lighting over the following pedestrian crossing, Ash Road, outside Post Office, outside the Convent School on the Borrisokane Road and on Summerhill outside CBS Primary School. I believe that in the interest of safety to users this work should be carried out as soon as possible".
