1. **NOTICE OF MOTION IN THE NAME OF COUNCILLOR V. O'DOWD**

"I call on Nenagh Town Council to provide a pedestrian crossing at Stafford Street, Nenagh, as part of the proposed roadworks scheme due to be carried out this year".
