**The Mayor, Cllr. T. Moylan presided.**

The Mayor welcomed all to the meeting and reflected on his year in office. He thanked his fellow members and the staff for their support during the year and highlighted certain issues which he was proud to have been involved with namely the opening of the Ard Cruidin Estate in Tyone, commencement of over 100 additional Cluid housing units in Tyone and Ballygraique, adoption of the Nenagh Town & Environs Development Plan, adoption of the Annual Budget with a 0% increase in rates, the commencement of public consultation on additional car parks at O'Rahilly Street and the Railway Station, successful application for feasibility grant for provision of CCTV system for the town, opening of the newly refurbished St. Paul's Playground, the unveiling of the newly restored Spout at Dublin Road, the commitment of monies to complete the Nenagh Castle Project, and the commitment of €600,000 to the refurbishment of the Town Hall. The Members and Town Manager congratulated Cllr. Moylan on his year as Mayor.

**1. Election of Mayor**

and agreed that Cllr. Farrell be elected Mayor.

Cllr. Farrell then took the chair stating that she was honoured to be elected Mayor and outlined her ambitions for the coming year as follows: -

- The role out of CCTV for Nenagh
- Securing the lease of the Castle Field from the OPW
- Upgrading of facilities at Nenagh Leisure Centre
- Greater interaction with the Tidy Towns Committee
- Community led weekend festival based around St. Patrick's Day incorporating a Mayor's Charity Ball
- Research and develop a formal link with an Eastern European town

- Adopt official street names and erection of bilingual street signs

Her fellow Members congratulated Cllr. Farrell on her election as Mayor. The Town Manager wished to be associated with these good wishes on his own behalf and that of the staff.

## **2. Election of Deputy Mayor**
