### **NOTICE OF MOTION IN THE NAME OF COUNCILLOR JOE O'CONNOR**

“That this Council be informed if contact has taken place between the Solicitor acting on behalf of Nenagh Town Council and the Monaree Residents Association. If so what are the proposals being put forward to resolve the impasse regarding compensation due to the residents of this Estate”.
